Perhaps you would like to be involved or take part in any of the following projects we are undertaking at the Museum. There would be a group of people working on each item so support/training would be given

1. Front of house – do you like talking to people. We need people to greet and chat to our visitors when the museum is open.
2. Oral histories – we are about to embark on capturing people's memories from living in Westbury and/or working in one of the town's industries.
3. We are researching each of the principal streets in Westbury, looking at the buildings, how they have changed, who lived there.
4. Inventories – we are looking at re-vamping our storage area with new racking and storage boxes. We have to inventory our collections and look at the best way to conserve them.
5. Photographs and images – we have a huge number of original photographs and images. We need to inventory and copy them and store them in the best way to conserve them for the future.
6. Exhibitions – as the museum space is not large, we try to change the exhibitions as regularly as we can so we encourage visitors to return over and over again. Every exhibition requires organisation and research.
7. Walks project – we wish to extend the number of walks around the town that we provide.
8. Design – we are always looking for anyone interested in designing leaflets, information boards etc.
9. Fundraising – the society and museum depend on fundraising to survive. We have a programme of talks, walks, events etc. but wish to expand on this.
